THE BOOK OF THE ACTS OF THE APOSTLES IS THE EARLY HISTORY OF THE CHURCH AFTER JESUS HAD RISEN, ASCENDED INTO HEAVEN AND SENT THE HOLY SPIRIT OF GOD UPON HIS FOLLOWERS.

IT IS A VERY IMPORTANT BOOK BECAUSE IT SHOWS US
VERY CLEARLY THAT THE HEALING, TEACHING MINISTRY
OF JESUS CONTINUES EVEN THOUGH JESUS IS NOT
PHYSICALLY VISIBLE. IT CONTINUES BECAUSE JESUS
PROMISED TO BE WITH US UNTIL THE END TIME.

SO WE MUST LOOK TO THE FAITHFUL FOLLOWERS OF
JESUS TO SEE AND TO EXPECT THAT MINISTRY OF JESUS
TO BE PRESENT WITH US.

THIS IS SPELLED OUT VERY OBVIOUSLY IN THE WORDS
OF JESUS TO THOMAS: 'BLESSED ARE THOSE WHO HAVE
NOT SEEN, AND YET BELIEVE.'

IS THIS HOW I LOOK TO THE CHURCH TODAY?

DO I EXPECT TO FIND IN THE CHURCH, THE FAITHFUL FOLLOWERS OF JESUS, THE CONTINUING WORK AND MISSION OF JESUS?

DO I LOOK TO THE CHURCH FOR TEACHING AND GUIDANCE? DO I LOOK TO THE CHURCH FOR THE CONTINUING HEALING TOUCH OF JESUS IN MY LIFE NOW?

THIS IS THE CHALLENGE OF JOHN'S WORDS TO US
TODAY: "THESE SIGNS ARE RECORDED SO THAT YOU
MAY BELIEVE THAT JESUS IS THE CHRIST, THE SON OF
GOD, AND THAT BELIEVING THIS YOU MAY HAVE LIFE
THROUGH HIS NAME."

DO I FEEL LIKE I HAVE THIS LIFE IN ME NOW?

DO I LOOK FOR JESUS AT WORK IN AND THROUGH THE CHURCH TODAY? OR DO I SIMPLY STOP AT THE CHURCH, AND NOT WHAT THE CHURCH HOLDS OUT TO US?
